

## **NOTICE OF PERSONAL DRIVER LICENSE EXTENSIONS**

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Department of Licensing (DOL) is continuing to extend Washington driver licenses. Licenses expiring March 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021 are extended (see details below).

### **Don't wait to renew**

These extensions are in effect for a limited time. DOL has temporary rules in place making almost everyone eligible for online renewals, so act now to renew your license. There is nothing to be gained by waiting, as extensions do not affect your renewal cycle. Your next cycle will begin on the date printed on your document no matter when you renew, and you'll pay the same amount you would have paid without an extension.

### **Extension details**

#### **2020**

- Licenses expiring March 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020 are valid 360 days past the date printed on the card.
- Licenses expiring July 1, 2020 through Sept. 30, 2020 are valid 270 days past the date printed on the card.
- Licenses expiring Oct. 1, 2020 through Dec. 31, 2020 are valid 180 days past the date printed on the card.

#### **2021**

- Licenses expiring Jan. 1, 2021 through March 31, 2021 are valid 90 days past the date printed on the card.

Drivers will not receive new licenses with new expiration dates. You can present this letter with an expired license if asked by law enforcement or others who need to verify your identity. Licenses with expiration dates that fall within the extension windows are not subject to penalties or late fees.
